## **Endura UV Thinner**

A REMINDER TO ALL DISTRIBUTORS:

It's been assumed that all distributors have been using UV Thinner when mixing paint since 1991. The following is a reminder of information sent in the past.

UV Thinner must be used to top up all formulas containing Clear 110 when headspace is available. This includes all colors, both solids and metallics.

To reduce time and the chance of a mixing error, Clear 111 can be used to make tinted paint instead of a combination of Clear 110 and UV Thinner. For further information on the use of Clear 111, please see attached copy of the June 2000 Technical Bulletin.

**Note: All low gloss, medium gloss, and no gloss colors must be made with the appropriate amounts of Clear 110 and UV Thinner.**
